## **RE: Mackenzie Valley Highway Project, Government of the Northwest Territories**

On October 12, 2023, the Government of the Northwest Territories (the developer) submitted it's *Developer's Assessment Report*. Since then, Review Board staff have had discussions about upcoming EA process steps with several parties. These discussions were high level and focused on the conformity check step and an overview of the typical steps that occur in the analysis phase of an assessment. These discussions were also in the context of CIRNAC's participant funding application process, which closed on November 2, 2023.

A summary of communications with various groups is provided below:

Déline Got'ine Government: phone conversation about typical steps during the analysis phase of an environmental assessment.

Łíídlų Kų́ę́ First Nation: phone conversation about typical steps during the analysis phase of an environmental assessment.
